## **Congratulations Ollie!**

Oliver Dingley showed his talent at the FINA Diving World Cup in Wuhan, China last week. Ollie took on the very best divers in the World in the 3m Springboard event.

Ollie placed 14<sup>th</sup> with a score of 406.85 in the prelim, top 18 went through to the semi final. The next day Ollie placed 10<sup>th</sup> with a score of 411.10, top 12 went through to the final.

Later Ollie scored 418.75 and came7<sup>th</sup> in the World! This also means he has a place in the Diving World Series in 2019, only the top 8 secured places will take part in the diving series which will be situated all over the world.

## 2018 Swim Ireland Selections

National Performance Director Jon Rudd has confirmed a selection of 5 divers who will compete in 4 major international events over the summer of 2018. They will compete at the FINA World Cup, LEN European Junior Championships, FINA World Junior Championships & the LEN European Senior Championships.

Ciara McGing, Tanya Watson & Anna Power will make their international debut at the LEN European Junior Championships from 25<sup>th</sup>June – 1<sup>st</sup> July in Helsinki, Finland. Anna and Ciara will make Irish history at the event becoming the first Irish pairing to compete in an international synchronised diving event.

The team for Senior Europeans will be Oliver Dingley and Jack Ffrench. Both will compete in the Men's 1m and 3m with Tanya Watson in 10m Individual. The event takes place in Edinburgh 6<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> August.

As well as European Senior and Junior Championships Tanya Watson will also compete at the FINA World Junior Championships in Kiev, Ukraine from 23<sup>rd</sup>–29<sup>th</sup> July.

## \*RESULTS\* Canada Grand Prix 2018

Ollie went to the Canada Grand Prix in Calgary on the  $10^{th} - 13^{th}$  May with Coach Damo. There were 112 divers from 19 countries, one of the busiest Grand Prix's there has been! There were a total of 33 divers in Ollie's 3m competition.

Ollie placed 12<sup>th</sup> in the 3m prelim with 364.75 progressing to the Semi – Final. In a grand Prix, the semi final is made up of two competitions with 6 spaces. Ollie finished 5<sup>th</sup> in Semi Final B scoring 389.40. Out of both semi finals Ollie finished ranked 8<sup>th</sup> overall.
